## Simon's Rock 2024 Alumni Reunion Begins Friday, May 31

GREAT BARRINGTON, MA— The 2024 Bard College at Simon's Rock Alumni Reunion will begin on Friday, May 31 through Sunday, June 2, 2024, and will feature a plethora of fun-filled activities for alumni and their families.
